In accordance with the provisions of Art. 20.9 of Law 37/1992, of December 28, on Value Added Tax, the amounts paid to the university are exempt from VAT. In the event that current legislation declares these payments subject to and not exempt from the tax, the University will charge the corresponding applicable VAT on said amounts.

- The total academic fees stipulated for each program include enrollment and monthly installments. This amount is the minimum payment accepted by the University, regardless of the number of credits enrolled, except for programs where partial enrollment is permitted.
- Fees apply to the academic year in which the student is enrolled and may vary for subsequent years. The prices applicable to the second and following years will be those published for the corresponding academic years.
- Students who enroll in additional credits, exceeding those indicated in the study plan for each program, shall pay, in addition to the corresponding monthly installment, the amounts resulting from multiplying the established unit prices for each credit by the number of additional credits.
- In the case of authorized partial enrollments, the credit-based payment system requires a review of the academic situation, credit transfers, and potential enrollment for each student. We recommend consulting with an advisor.

« CONCEPTS NOT INCLUDED

The payment of academic fees covers formal university education. The following concepts are not included in the academic fees and must therefore be paid separately by each student:

- Travel expenses for students to internship centers (hospitals, health institutions, hotels, museums, courts, external sports centers and facilities, etc.).
- Within the framework of the MBA in Sports Management, as well as in any other degree that includes off-campus activities, whether in other cities in Spain or abroad, flights, travel, and accommodation are not included in the degree price. These expenses are the student's responsibility unless officially communicated otherwise by the University.
- The purchase of individual equipment required for the degrees (lab coats, scrubs, and special medical footwear; protective equipment; clinical instruments and dental consumables; personal tools and drawing boards; footwear, clothing, and sports kits, etc.).
- Books, stationery, and computer equipment. All of these must be purchased by each student from their preferred suppliers, unless otherwise expressly indicated by the University.
- Degree issuance fees and certificate fees are not included in the enrollment amount.

Payment of enrollment fees

The amount corresponding to the enrollment fee must be paid each academic year and applies to all students.

To secure their place, admitted students must complete the payment for the enrollment fee in a timely and proper manner.

• Payment methods for both concepts

- Online POS (TPV online).
- Bizum.
- Flywire via uax.flywire.com (exclusively for payments from countries with a Flywire agreement).
- Credit/Debit card at the Villanueva de la Cañada campus.
- Bank transfer via the PAGONxt* payment method.
- Cash deposit into the UAX Banco Santander account indicated above.

* **PagoNxt** is a secure payment method that assigns a unique and personalized account number to each candidate. Paying through this personal and non-transferable account number ensures the security, privacy, and convenience of your payments. You can find your personalized account number information in the UAX Admissions Portal. It is important to keep this information and share it with the student's financial sponsor, if applicable, for future payments to the University.

Formalization of enrollment

- Implies confirmation by the student of the acceptance of the place and, therefore, the desire to proceed with all necessary procedures for enrollment at **Universidad Alfonso X el Sabio**.
- In any case, to enroll in Postgraduate studies, the candidate must meet and provide the documentation regarding the **Legal Requirements for Access to the University** within the period indicated on page 6 of the Postgraduate Admission Guide.
- The amount paid for enrollment will **only be reimbursed** in cases where the student proves they do not meet these requirements. The request must be made in writing to the University Admissions Office, providing the supporting documentation that justifies the student's situation. If not properly justified, the request cannot be processed.
- It will also be reimbursed in cases where, even if the legal access requirement is met, students **withdraw their enrollment** and request it reliably before the University Admissions Office using a specific document for this purpose, within **14 calendar days** (Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays included) from the date of the enrollment payment.
- Exceptionally, if the University cancels the program for which the student has requested a place due to not reaching the minimum number of students established for its delivery, the University will reimburse the amounts collected for enrollment.
- Said payment does not, under any circumstances, constitute the formalization of enrollment, nor, therefore, the formalization of the teaching contract. To enroll in Postgraduate studies, the candidate must complete the administrative procedures and provide the **Legal Requirements for Access to the University**; as set out in Point 5 of the Postgraduate Admission Guide (page 6).
- The enrollment fee shall be paid each academic year and applies to all UAX students.

Tuition payment

1. By Direct Debit. Mandatory method for all students enrolled in a face-to-face (on-campus) degree. You must have a bank account within the **SEPA territory** (Single Euro Payments Area). Currently enabled for accounts in Spain and France.

1.1 Annual Payment: A single installment for the total tuition amount, benefiting from a **2% early payment discount** on the tuition fee (check legal terms). The University will issue the receipt for collection within the first 5 days of your first month of classes.

1.2 Monthly Payment: A financial facility granted by the UNIVERSITY, allowing the tuition amount to be split into the corresponding monthly installments. The University will issue a receipt for collection within the first 5 days of each month.

2. In case of temporarily not having a bank account in Spain and/or France:

2.1 Annual Payment: According to the payment dates established in section 2.3.

- Via online transfer to the **personalized PagoNxt account** number assigned to you during your admission and enrollment process.
- If you do not have this personalized number, via online transfer to the **UAX account at BANCO SANTANDER: ES50 0049 1958 81 2210000511 BSCHESMMXXX**. Indicating the student's full name, surnames, and ID number.
- Through **Flywire**, for countries included and authorized to use this payment platform, via **uax.flywire.com** (exclusively for payments from non-EU countries).

2.2 Monthly Payment: You must pay the amount corresponding to the **first monthly installment** in advance before the start of classes, according to the payment dates in section 2.3. For subsequent installments, you must open an account in a Spanish banking institution—that can be done at the Banco Santander branch located on our campus—and complete the direct debit authorization through the UAX Campus portal.

2.3 Payment Dates

- If you processed your enrollment application **before August 15**, you must make the annual payment or the first monthly installment (depending on the payment method selected) **before August 20**.
- If you processed your enrollment application **after August 15**, you must make the annual payment or the first monthly installment (depending on the payment method selected) within the **5 calendar days** following the formalization of your enrollment.

The legal bases for study aids—including specifics, exclusions, exceptions, terms, and requirements to apply, as well as conditions for maintenance and renewal—are available for consultation at www.uax.com, in the **Scholarships, Aid, and Financing** section.

- Tuition discounts established in the regulations, as well as those from agreements with specific groups, scholarships, or study aids granted by Universidad Alfonso X el Sabio, **cannot be combined**, with the exception of the early payment discount. The most beneficial option for the student will be applied.
- UAX entrance scholarships are incompatible with any other university scholarship or aid, but are compatible with those requested from other public or private organizations, unless that organization declares its own incompatibility.
- In the event of any discrepancy between the information provided by an advisor and the University's Fees and Regulations, the latter shall prevail.



The aids listed in this document are limited and subject to availability; therefore, they are not guaranteed until the enrollment fee has been paid. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the granting of such aid shall be subject to the completion of all payments specified in the Academic Fees in the time and manner indicated in said document, as well as the submission of all required documentation to reliably prove compliance with all necessary conditions, as informed to the student in this document or in the legal bases for the aids published in the corresponding website section (www.uax.com/becas-ayudas-y-financiacion).
